July 22 - Brit Floyd

Brit Floyd returns to the stage in 2025 with their biggest and most spectacular production to date, celebrating the 50th anniversary of Pink Floyd's classic album '**Wish You Were Here**', complete with a stunning laser and light show, iconic circular screen, inflatables and theatrics. Released in 1975 and featuring four of the band's most beloved songs, 'Shine On You Crazy Diamond', 'Welcome to the Machine', 'Have a Cigar' and the title track, 'Wish You Were Here' is widely regarded as one of the greatest albums of all time.

July 25 – Lucy Darling

A semi-improvised comedy show with the grand dame of magic, **Lucy Darling** is known the world over for her wit, her charm, and her exceptionally good hair. Lucy's show is a wonderful mix of playful improvisational comedy, hilarious, witty writing, and impossible magical feats. Miss Darling is a 15-time Award-Winning Entertainer featured in the Guinness Book of World Records and Ripley's Believe It or Not. C.K. is the creator, writer, director, and star of the Peabody Award winning shows "Louie" and "Horace and Pete." C.K. also co-wrote, directed, and appeared in the feature film "Fourth of July," released in theaters nationwide in July 2022.

July 25 – Chris Fleming (2 performances)

Chris Fleming has a one hour performance special out on Peacock titled HELL. He has amassed over 80 million views on his Youtube channel and has appeared in Abbott Elementary, LOOT, Comedy Central's CORPORATE, Waffles and Mochi, Netflix's Last Laugh as well as voicing characters in the Great North, Adventure Time, Summer Camp Island and Bigtop Burger.
